We are working in partnership with the NHS trusts across the same area to look at how children's surgery should be provided in the future.

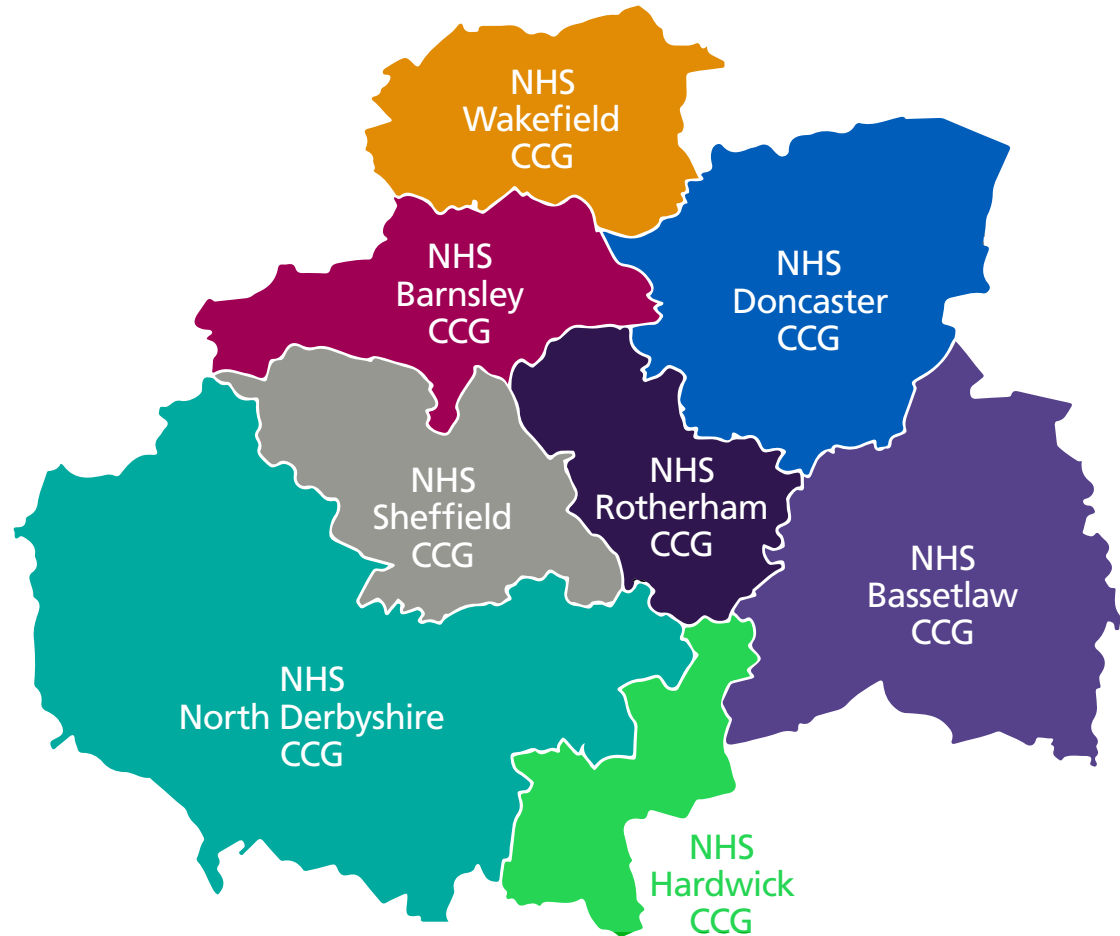


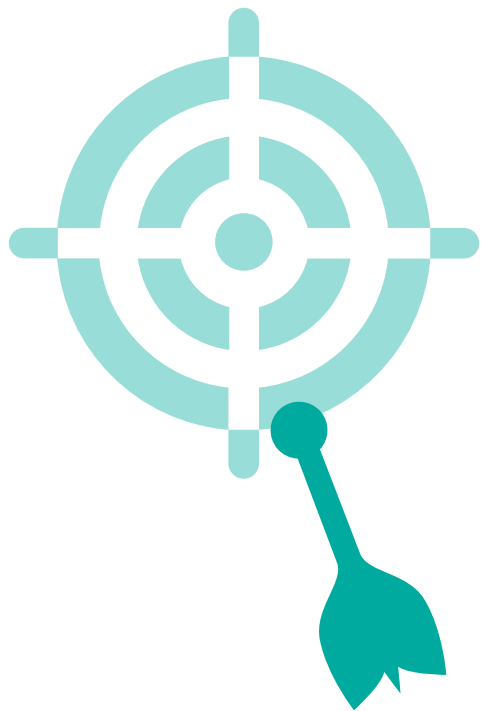

shortage of some health
care professionals**

Doctors, nurses and healthcare staff all agree that the way children's surgery is provided needs to change. This could include how we provide services locally and how you access them.





People tell us they want their care to be as close to home as possible and this is what we are trying to do. We want to plan and buy as much of your care as close to you as we can.

The first two are not viable.

We are therefore looking at the **third option – working across all the hospitals in the area – in a way yet to be determined.**



We are asking parents, carers and young people what matters to them when accessing care and treatment. We will take all the feedback and it will be used to shape the options and plans before we consult on changes.
